- A photo submission with application (snapshot is acceptable)
- Submit a short personal essay of at least 150 words (no more than 250) answering the question, *“Why do I wish to study acting at the Neighborhood Playhouse School of the Theatre’s Junior School Summer Program?”*
- One (1) personal reference letter from a coach, teacher, or someone who knows you well.
- One (1) professional reference letter from a director or coach who can speak to your abilities
- F-1 Visa form for International Students (fees apply)*
- Interview & audition with the Director of the Junior School upon submission of all above mentioned materials. Please prepare a 1 minute contemporary monologue.

Location of Interview: Neighborhood Playhouse Skype/FaceTime

Application and all materials must be submitted prior to your interview. If accepted into the program you will receive an official letter by email stating so within 5-7 business days of your interview. You will also be sent a medical/photo release form, enrollment/handbook agreement, and other necessary forms to complete admission. These must be filled out, signed and returned to the school by the deadlines with \$300 in USD (check, money order, credit card, or wire transfer) to secure your child’s space in the program. These forms also ensure that your child is able to fully participate in the physical activities necessary in most of the classes.
